AMCJ is led by Chief Executive Officer. He is the head of AMCJ Administration & Academic activities are looked after by the principal.

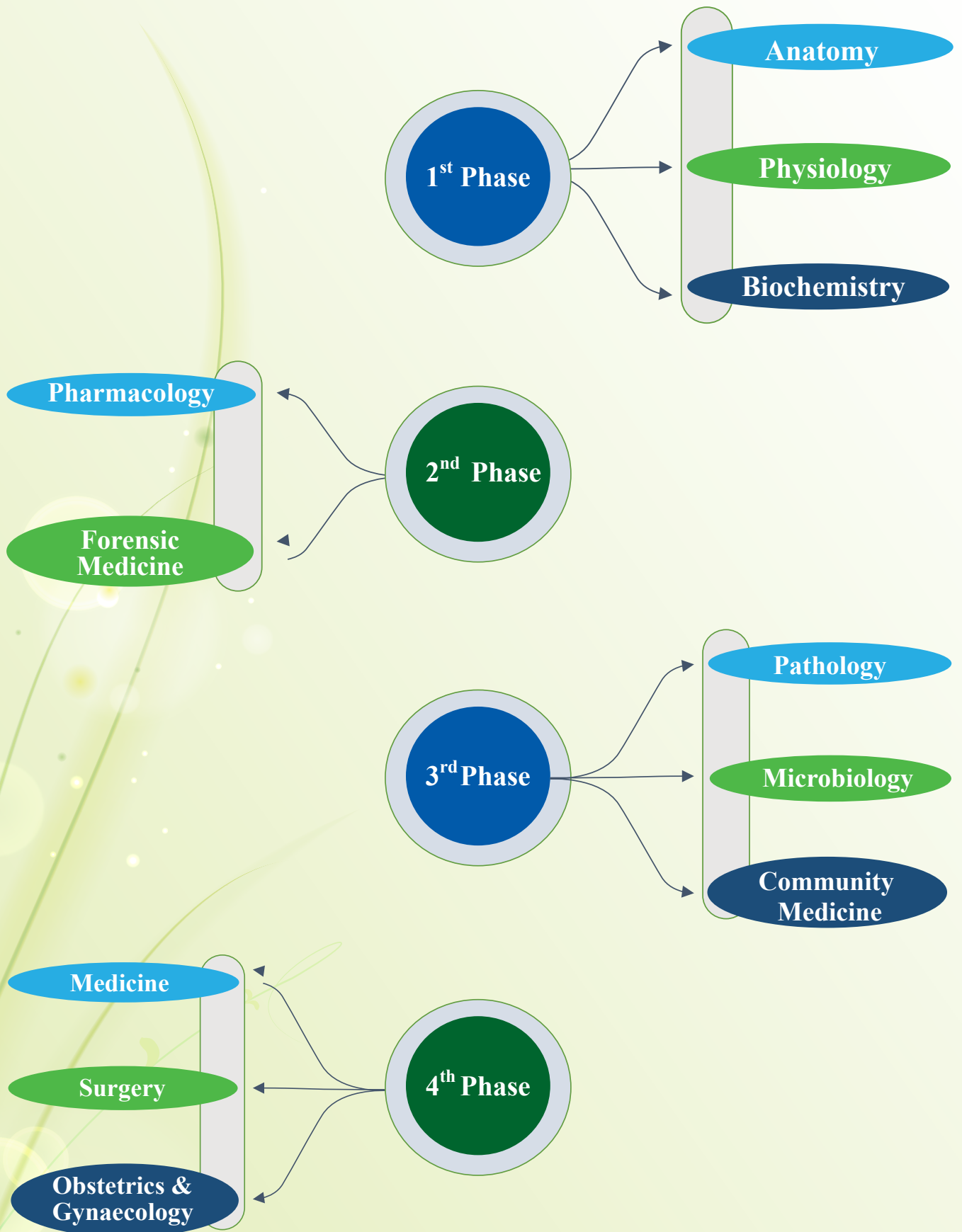

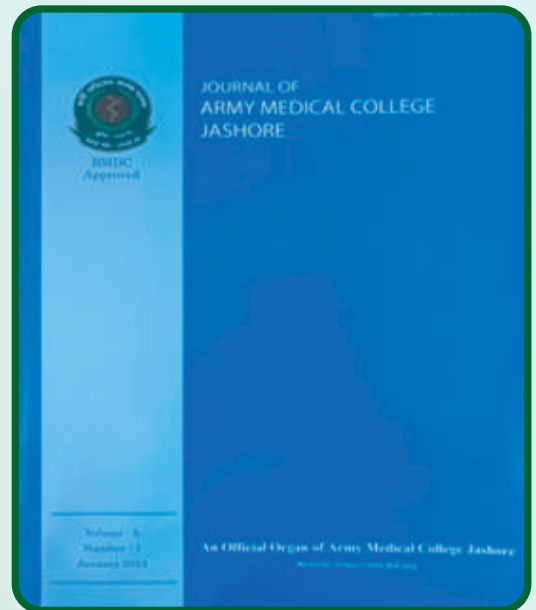

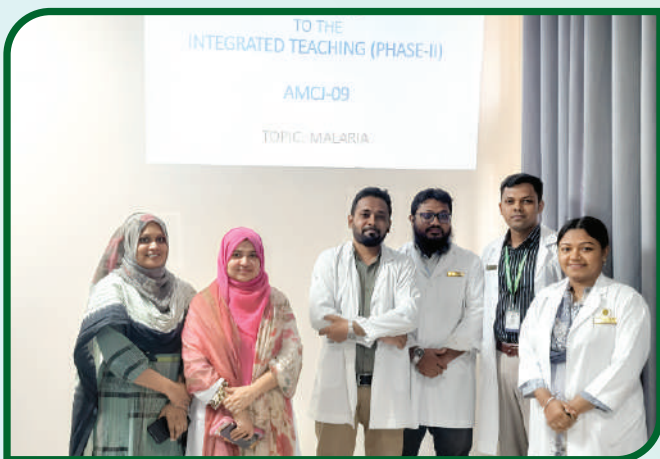

Accommodation & Others Facilities

Army Medical College Jashore has two separate hostels each of 26,640 sqft for male and female named by two freedom fighters, Lt Col Abdul Hye and Captain Setera Begum (BP), respectively. It can accommodate total 500 students with 90 rooms in these two buildings. Each building has the facilities

Transportation

The location of AMCJ is in convenient place where everyone can reach within the shortest time period by air, train, and bus. It has own transportation facility which includes 1 × Microbus, 1 × Human Hauler, 2 × Bus. These transports are used for daily ward class, pickup and drop-off for the students at CMH, and on their way home.

500 Bedded Hospital: AMCJ has planned to construct a 500 bedded teaching hospital. The construction work (B+G+1) has started whose foundation stone was laid on 13th November 2024 & earth excavation has been completed by 11.37% and the work is expected to be completed by Oct, 2026.

Admission Information

Army Medical College Jashore (AMCJ) admits students through a transparent, merit-based procedure aligned with national regulations and Armed Forces oversight. Please read the national and international admission instructions carefully.

Key point

AMCJ entrance examination and central selection are conducted annually under the authority of the Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC).

For National (Bangladeshi) Applicants

Eligibility:

- Completion of SSC and HSC (or equivalent) with Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
- Meet minimum GPA/marks and other criteria published by DGME for the admission year.

How to apply

- **Online application to AFMC:** Apply via the AFMC admission portal and indicate AMCJ as a preferred college.
- **Admission test & merit:** Sit the admission examination as announced; merit and allocation are made per DGME rules and quotas.
- **AMCJ allocation:** AMCJ receives students as per the AFMC allocation list for Army Medical Colleges.
- **College formalities (on selection):** Present original documents for verification, complete medical fitness examination, pay prescribed fees, sign required undertakings and complete joining formalities.
- **Important:** All national applicants must follow the AFMC admission circular and timelines. AMCJ will conduct college-level verification only after central allocation.

For International (Foreign) Applicants:

Foreign applicants may complete the entire admission process independently. All international students must follow the official guidelines of the Directorate General of Medical Education (DGME) and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangladesh before applying to Army Medical College Jashore (AMCJ).

1. Eligibility Requirements

- Minimum combined GPA 7.0 in O- & A-Level/equivalent.
- Minimum GPA 3.5 (60% marks) in Biology at A-Level.
- O- & A-Level (or equivalent) must be completed within 3 years.
- GPA is calculated using the top 5 subjects in O-Level and three science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) in A-Level.

2. Attestation of Documents

All academic documents must be attested by:

- Ministry of Education and Foreign Affairs (home country)
- Bangladesh Embassy/Mission. (NEET scorecard required for Indian applicants.)

3. DGME Equivalence Certificate

Apply online through the DGME Foreign Students Portal and upload all attested documents to obtain the official Equivalence & Eligibility Certificate.

4. Application to AMCJ

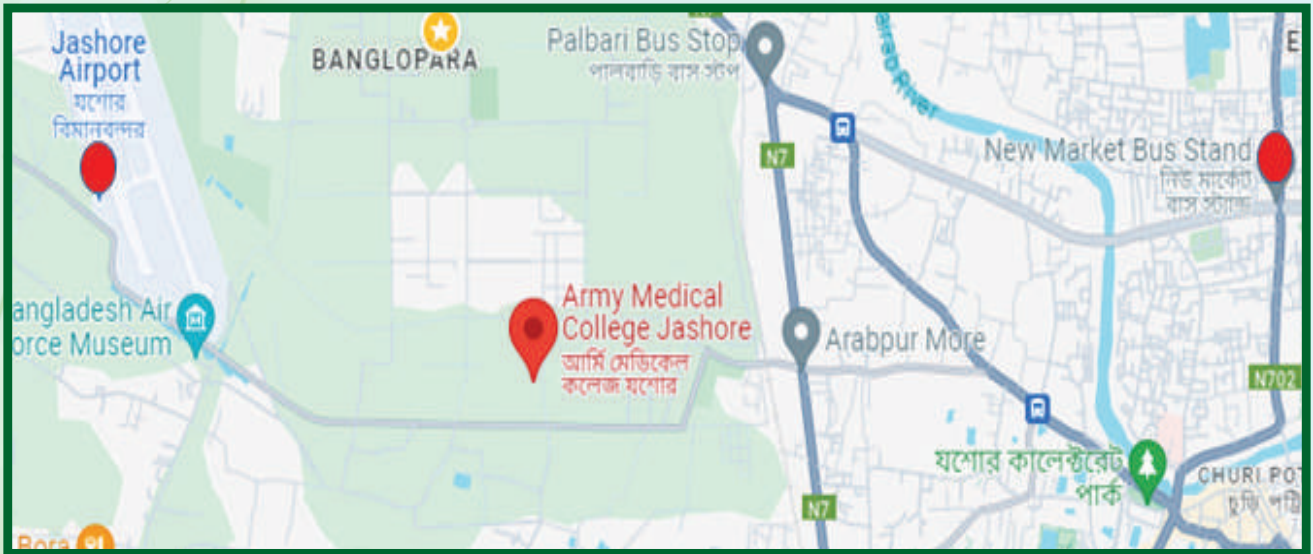
Email scanned copies of the equivalence certificate, attested documents, passport, photographs, NOC, and the AMCJ application form to the official college email addresses.

5. Offer Letter, Visa & Final Admission

Eligible applicants receive a Provisional Offer Letter for visa processing and fee instructions. After visa approval and payment of required fees, students travel to Bangladesh, submit original documents, complete medical check-up, and finalize enrollment at AMCJ.
